

Agree with:

Collaboration among agencies and with FirstNet, and with Federal partners

Collaboration in ways that eliminates stovepiped funding streams (telemedicine, FirstNet, libraries, etc.)

In Idaho, they were able to leverage relationship with Idaho public broadcasting to enhance state LMR system, and we need to be vigilant about identifying what networks we may have here in Alaska

Changes to make:

Reduce focus on EOCs and more on centers (like PSAPs) that are used on a daily basis

Address the fact that all the money comes from the same GF or federal source. We should build multipurpose infrastructures that allow for public safety priority *when needed*, and for use by ALL when public safety doesn't need it. Ultimately that boils down to the need for governance / coordination.

Suggest emphasis on sharing infrastructure

Missing:

Need to mention governance mechanism to avoid duplicating infrastructure

Need to consider the impacts of international issues, trans-border communications

Should have a needs assessment of public safety requirements, and then determine what needs to be enhanced, extended, updated.

Lets not confuse normal broadband with public safety grade broadband standards. Need to include specific language regarding system security, both cyber and physical

We need to speak to the need for lifecycle sustainment (ongoing maintenance, operations, system updates, infrastructure replacement, etc.)
